Dear Parents

As part of our topic about 'A Tale of a City', Class 3 and Class 5 will be visiting York Museum, where the children will take part in one of the following workshops: Jorvik Life or Life in Anglo Saxon York. Both workshops will be a 1 hour 30 minute interactive sessions. Pupils discover and explore life in Eoforwic (Anglo Saxon York) or Jorvik (Viking York) and explore artistry, trade, home life, burials through the objects and evidence found in York. They will dress up as Vikings or Anglo Saxons and join in practical activities such as jewelry and belt making.

Following the workshops, children will visit York Minster where they will be given a guided tour (especially for children) of this magnificent building, which will reflect its history and significance to the city today.

The trip will take place on Wednesday 28^{th} June and will cost £15 per child. This includes the cost of the workshops, the guided tour of the Minster and the cost of transport. The Friends of School have very kindly donated £50 per class towards the cost of the trip and we very much appreciate their support: thank you. We shall leave school shortly after 9am and return by 3:30pm.

Please send the permission slip to school by **Monday 19**th **June** and your voluntary donation of £15 in a named envelope, or alternatively you can provide consent and make your payment via Parentpay. All contributions are very gratefully received, as I am sure you will appreciate that if enough donations are not received then the trip cannot go ahead.

The children will need a packed lunch with drinks (no cans), as well as usual break time snacks. These should be packed in a rucksack that is easy to carry. A packed lunch can be ordered from school but this must be **before Monday 19**th **June**. Children may wear suitable everyday clothing or school uniform, but please ensure they have sensible walking shoes/trainers/boots and a showerproof coat. If it is sunny please apply sun-cream before coming to school.











Children may bring up to £4 pocket money to spend in either the museum or Minster shops.
If your child requires any travel medication please ensure it is placed in an envelope which is
clearly labelled with the correct dosage and given to their class teacher on the morning of
the trip.
