Welcome

School Information

Timings

A reminder that the school gates will open at 8:50 am every morning. Please do not arrive and queue before 8:45am outside school.

Mobile Phones

Please can all people using the school site remember that <u>we do not permit the use of</u> <u>mobile phones whilst on the premises</u>, unless in a designated area or a Senior Member of staff has given permission. This is to safeguard children and all other people at school.

Attendance

We are very grateful to all parents who support their children by ensuring they attend school regularly and punctually. It allows teachers the best possible opportunity to support the children to reach their full attainment potential. Last year our school attendance was 95% and the Government's recommended minimum attendance rate for primary school children is 96%. This academic year we will be focusing on pupil attendance and punctuality and we ask parents to work with us by:

- Making medical/dental appointments outside of school times, unless essential
- Not booking holidays during term time
- Only keeping your child off school for genuine illness
- Arriving on time for school every day
- Contacting you child's teacher if there are any issues that might affect attendance
